# A Small Cog in the Big Machine

The world's longest railway tunnel is built under the Gotthard Massif – equipment supplied by HOSCH ensures perfect operation of tunnel excavators and processing plants

Ear-splitting noise. Fine dust is in the sic like on immenercable will - cuided up by a powerful tunnel excavator. Centimetre by centimetre, the 10 metre wide drilling head sinks deeper and deeper into the mountain. There are about 2,500 metres of rock above the Gotthard Massif. The longest railway tupped in the world with a length of \$7 km is currently built under the Swiss Ales, to be completed in the year 2018. Involved in the project: scrapers from HOSCH. All four tunnel excavators as well as most of the recycline plants are equipped with high-quality technology from Recklinohausen.

"I feel like being part of this construction size, like a small cognetic that makes its contribution to the successful ouscome of this gigantic project", HOSGH employee Uwe Matchaceck says, In 2002, the serviceman installed his first scrapers at the Gorthard construction size, Since then, the 40-yearold makes his way there once a month in order to nevie the sergues on size

# and to replace wearing parts.

What looks rather inconspicuous from outside, reaches dimensions inside the mountain that cannot be command to a

normal construction site, "You only see a his hole in the monetain". Here Machaczek says. The tunnel has five en trances: Erstfeld in the North and Bodio in the South; in between there are three further access tunnels in Amsteg, Sedrun and Exido. At the individual entrances. only some gravel and rock recycling plants show that there is construction work going on at the Gottbard Main Turnel. However, the really exciting things happen under ground: A total of four tunnel excavators - each of them more than 400 m long - of the German company Herrenknecht ceaselessly eat through the rock from two directions.

That way, they make room for two tubes, through which the trains are going

In 1996, the first blasting works for the access tunnels began. In November 2002. the tunnel excavators started to operate. "The conveyor belts, on which the rock is being transported out of the mountain, were at first equipped with the scraper system of a competitor, which however, did not work in the best possible way". Thee Machaczek says. Shortly after the beginning of the excavation work the serviceman installed the first HOSCH scrapers, Today six HOSCH scrapers type B6 at each of the tunnel excavators ensure smooth operation. In addition to the tunnel excavators, there are 45 scrapers type C1 and B6 in operation in the gravel pit and concrete Sedrup, 20 HEA type B6 clean the con-

At the Gotthard Main Tunnel, more than 400 workers take approximately 24 billion tons of rock out of the mountain until the completion of the tunnel This amount would be sufficient for building five Cheops pyramids. Most of the extracted stone is crushed, recycled and processed to high-quality concrete used for construction. The tunnellers use it for finishing and lining works at the tunnel. Out of the mountain for the mountain - recycling the material with a minimal load to the environment alreads played a major part in the planning phase of this gigantic project.
